

Cyber Safety Officer

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To develop and deliver training modules for creating awareness amongst schools and communities.
- The incumbent will also be required to contribute to the delivery of workshops and conferences as required according to the project framework.
- The incumbent shall finalize the training reports based on agreed timeline and perform any other duties as assigned by senior members of ICPF.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

- **Technical** Ideally, a basic interest in and understanding of how websites and content distribution over the internet works and the fundamentals of online security/personal security on the web. However, they do not need to be a technical expert.
- **Legal** Able to assimilate and apply the relevant legislation. The person should also be comfortable presenting to stakeholders such as schools. This will include the ability to describe and discuss graphic content in a factual and pragmatic tone.
- **Subject-matter** Experience with some aspect of combatting child sexual exploitation is not essential but can be very beneficial.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

A person with graduation degree in field of Law, Criminology, Psychology, Social Work, or Computer Science.

- A basic understanding of website technology, online security, and personal security on the web, which can be acquired through online courses, certifications, or workshops.
- Experience in working with child victims or in related sectors such as social work, law enforcement, or child protection would be an advantage.
- Strong communication skills, including the ability to present information to stakeholders such as law enforcement, in a factual and pragmatic tone.
- The ability to work in a team, manage multiple tasks simultaneously, and maintain confidentiality is also important.
